



COACH, SPECTATOR AND TEAM DECORUM

Each team is expected to follow the spectator code of conduct and the following outline for coaching and playing during the game. This is a strict policy that will be enforced.

All bench decorum is set by the state high school league and Power To Play Sports events follow the same exact guidelines.

The are, but not limited to:

1. Only the head coach is allowed to stand during the game. All assistant coaches are required to remain seated at all times during games. One warning is provided, and all other violations result in a technical foul assigned to the head coach. Two technical foul violations results in head coach being dismissed from the bench and suspended for the following game.
2. Only the head coach is allowed to communicate with the officials. The assistant coaches per high school league rules are not allowed to communicate with the officials unless directed to do so by the officials.
3. Players are to remain seated during play, with the exception of cheering for their teammates. Upon cheering, the high school league rules require players returning to their seats immediately.
4. Profanity of any nature, by coaches, fans, or players will result in an automatic technical foul assigned to the player and head coach.
5. Any player or coach entering the court of play unauthorized will automatically receive a technical foul and be dismissed for the remainder of the game, and suspended for the next game.
6. Fans (parents, grandparents, and all team fans) are expected to support their team and refrain from negative comments made to the opposing team, coaches, and officials. Violation of this will result in the head coach being addressed by the officials (warning) and the site director informed. Second violation of this will result in a technical foul assigned to the head coach. In addition, the team forfeits 5 points, and the opposing team is awarded the ball. No free throws are shot. Lastly, the parent is removed from the facility for the remainder of the weekend. Failure to leave the facility results in the team forfeiting the game, remainder of weekend play, and tournament entry fee.

7. All spectator code of conduct is enforced within the facility, all areas of the building, including the parking lot, and all areas surrounding the tournament are included.

Continual violation of this decorum that creates an unsafe and threatening environment to anyone involved will result in the local police authorities being called to the tournament.
